

In response to past events and the spread of hate speech and intolerance related to migration and refugees related topics, APIS Institute created an educational toolkit on the topics for the teachers so they can use it in the classrooms. The teachers are facing hate speech against newcomers on daily basis but are unsure how to respond.

In order to give migration and refugees the missing context in the classrooms, the toolkit offered a historical context along with less media biased and more realistic migration and refugees related stories.

The toolkit is a result of joint forces of APIS Institute and internationally renowned experts from the fields of migration and refugees. It gained support from the Government Communication Office of Republic of Slovenia. The collaborative result is a MULTIMEDIA EDUCATIONAL TOOLKIT on IMMIGRATION, EMIGRATION AND REFUGESM.



In response to past events and the spread of hate speech and intolerance, APIS Institute from Ljubljana has produced materials to be used by teachers as part of their regular programs or optional classes.



The toolkit is designed such a way that students learn about the history and reasoning for migrations both, from and to Slovenia. They hear personal stories, but the experts complement the personal narrative with facts, figures and history.



By using the toolkit the students learn more about the reasons and hardship of refugees, they become aware of emigration of Slovenes and immigration into Slovenia and the reasons underlying these choices, as well as the challenges posed by integration. Multimedia content is complemented by short exercises designed on the basis of nonformal education principles.

The multimedia material is not only informative but also enables students to identify themselves with personal stories and, through non-formal exercises, invite them to participate in the learning process and constructively self-reflect using an artistic approach.
